**Y**oung Women’s Mentorship program paired 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students at Taft Elementary School, Williamson Elementary, and Boardman Center Middle School with women mentors from various professional backgrounds.

During the 2017-2018 school year, 49 mentees and 35 mentors are taking part in the program. The girls are connecting with positive female role models, addressing social and emotional issues relevant to adolescent girls, and focusing on academic success and leadership.

The students also take part in Junior Achievement, which focuses on financial education and career options, as well as a special speaker series and field trips
