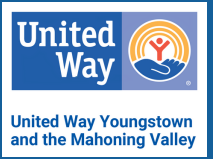


Education & Mentoring

United Way SUCCESS AFTER 6

Success After 6 provides wrap around services to students and their families and has brought new enrichment partners, successful educational engagements, and academic support. This includes focusing on literacy, math, and social and emotional skills with the goal of increasing day school attendance and family engagement.

In 2022, SA6 expanded to Valley Christian and Sebring's B.L. Miller Elementary School after working with them through Success by 6 —both schools have since seen progress in academics, social needs and behavioral issues.

435

Served during the 2022-2023 school year through our SA6 afterschool program in grades K-6.

Attendance
84%

SA6 afterschool had an 89% overall attendance rate. Our 41 family engagement nights saw an 82% average attendance.

Young Women's Mentorship

In 4 schools, 112 young women enrolled in the program with 50 mentors to guide them through life's challenges and provide consistent, positive support.

Care Closets

In one year, we launched 6 closets, helping 3,321. In addition, 1,710 families were served on 45 fresh food days.

Vision

In 2022, we officially brought a Vision Van to the Mahoning Valley at 3 K-12 schools. 5,443 students were provided a vision screening and an eye exam. 200 YSU nursing students aided in 970 screenings and 730 pairs of free prescription glasses were distributed to those who failed and were examined by a doctor on site.

Report Card Mentoring

In 3 schools, 48 volunteers mentored 185 students after each report card distribution to discuss grades, attendance, and behavior and set goals for the next 9 weeks. Students who meet with their mentors are 52% less likely than their peers to skip a day of school.

10 Point Assessment Increase

654 Students

This 4-week summer program provided 654 children and their families with unique learning engagements as well as resources and tools to take home in preparation for kindergarten. In 2022, we saw an increase of 10 points based off the Ohio Early Learning Standards Assessment. During our 3 Family Literacy Nights, we provided families with tools and resources from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library focusing on aiding parents on how to read to and with their children. In 2022, 6,784 children ages 0-5 were enrolled and 9,659 children graduated from the program.
