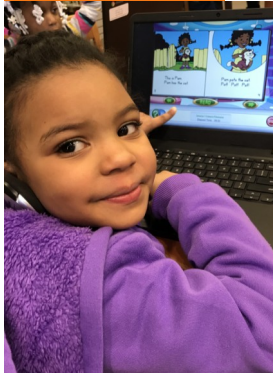


# CHILDHOOD SUCCESS

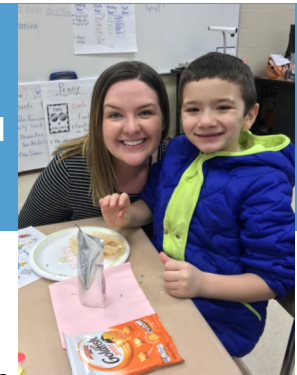
