Young Women’s Mentorship program paired 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students at Taft Elementary School and Boardman Center Middle School with women mentors from various professional backgrounds.

During the 2019-2020 school year, 43 mentees and 42 mentors took part in the program. The girls connect with positive female role models, address social and emotional issues relevant to adolescent girls, and focus on academic success and leadership.

The students also take part in Junior Achievement, which focuses on financial education and career options, as well as a special speaker series and field trips.

98% of the students at Taft and Boardman improved their grades during at least one grading period or more.

88% of the students at Taft and Boardman improved their school attendance during at least one grading period or more.

94% of the students at Taft and Boardman improved their behavior.
