Mentor Instructions

Arrive at the School

Sign In

Young adults who face an opportunity gap but have a *mentor* are **55% more likely** to enroll in college than those who don't have a mentor.

Students who meet regularly with their mentors are **52% less likely** than their peers to skip a day of school.
