The United Way's Centofanti Volunteer Resource Center is the wheelhouse for many of our initiatives. Volunteering as a work group

Workgroup experiences are offered year-round at the Centofanti Volunteer Center. Projects for groups to assist with are usually completed in two-hour work windows. Morning, Afternoon, and Evening hours are available. Light refreshments, coffee, and bottled water will be available to all volunteers. We welcome your group to stay and use our facility to accommodate a group breakfast or lunch if desired. We have local caterer recommendations upon request.
